Fostering involvement among all those concerned about the issue and enlisting their help in a global effort to inform politicians, media, academia, the business community, and others on the issue

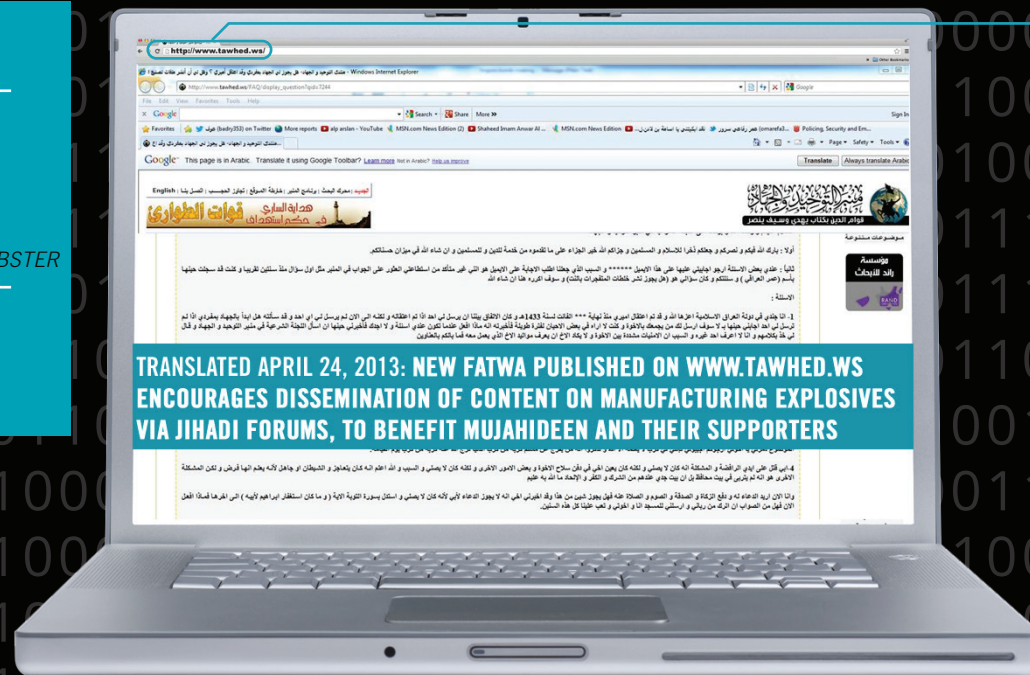

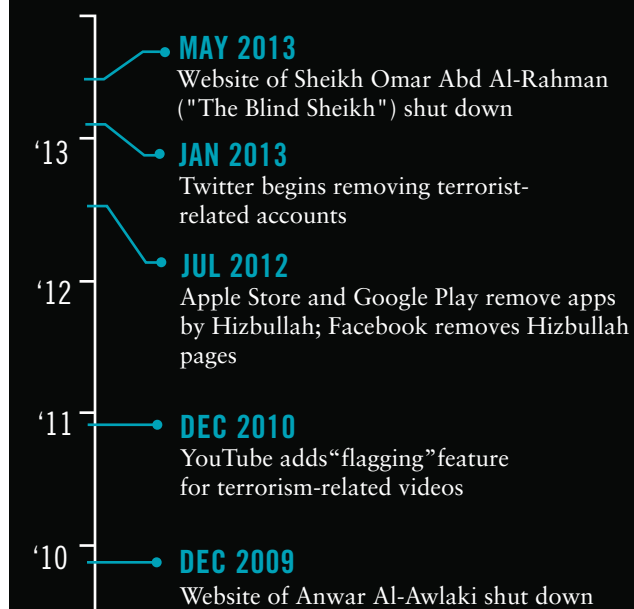
